Thank you for taking the time in applying for Media Accreditation for the 2009 series of the D1NZ National Drifting Championship, We are looking forward to an accelerating season with D1NZ taking drifting to new boundaries. To gain accreditation you must adhere to the follow Outlined herewith.

General Terms:

Granted media accreditation to any D1NZ event in New Zealand legally binds the Applicant and their representing organisation/ company in full to media terms and Conditions.

- Media representative/s agree to conduct themselves accordingly and within expectation/s of the D1NZ Management.
- Media representative will adhere to all venue and management safety regulations and protocols.
- Media representative will refer to and represent all acquired information/ correspondence on behalf of D1NZ in an accurate and correct manner befitting the event, including naming rights, sponsors, publication rules and associated licensees and/or assignees.
- Media representative must liaise with D1NZ Management for all coverage, content and end-result representation.
- Media representative will forward final sample of video/ magazine/ article/ website coverage prior to publication for authentication and final media release.
- D1NZ in some cases will require past coverage of events to gain acceptance.
- D1NZ organisers retain right of refusal/ entry to any media individual/ representative/ or entity regardless of media accreditation status.
- Media representative agrees to fair and unbiased reporting and will not partake in any form of promotional activity on behalf of or in association with traders/ businesses / car clubs/ individuals and/or organizations unless authorized by D1NZ.
- All rights are reserved by D1NZ, a breach in terms and conditions can result in legal action.

- All Media MUST report to media briefing's and all attendees must show ID at the gate that must match the name on your pass, each year you will be sent a full year's pass, failure to comply with this will result in no entry.
- All Media MUST attend media briefing and de-briefing when attending any D1NZ event.

All media must show up to all D1NZ events with a NZ standards High visibility shirt, which must state Media, these are available on loan on the day to media but must be returned – failure to do so will result in a \$100.00 invoice under the media representatives name.

There are selected areas in which Media will only be allowed, these areas are mandatory at all D1NZ events, All Photographers will be provided these locations in media briefings.

Magazine, Website and Video Footage Terms:

Any magazine, website or video production company that wishes to cover any D1NZ Event for use in a commercial venture must first seek prior approval from D1NZ the intentions must be submitted in writing and must outline/ adhere in the following manner:

- You must submit full disclosure and intention of content usage.
 - Nominate the companies involved/ associated in the pre/ post production of content.
 - Mediums intended for usage of content (i.e. DVD, TV, Magazine, Website, etc).
 - D1NZ does not permit any duplication or forwarding of obtained content to outside parties without written consent from D1NZ.
 - Accurate representation of D1NZ must be strictly adhering to, including naming rights, sponsors, licensees and image portrayal i.e. The D1NZ National Drifting Championship. Track naming and driver sponsors and naming.
- D1NZ reserves the right for request of all images, text, and footage taken in part or whole at any of its events for purposes of banning, internal productions and/or reference and marketing. Acquired footage at all times remains the property of D1NZ for legal rights.
